Dr Lyndon da Cruz did both his medical undergraduate and doctorate trainings at the University of Western Australia. He carried out his post doctoral research on the Howard Florey fellowship (NHMRC and Royal Society) in London. He completed retinal specialty training in both the UK and Australia. He is currently a consultant Ophthalmic Surgeon at Moorfields Eye Hospital in London. He holds the academic position of Honorary Reader at the Institute of Ophthalmology, University College London.

Dr Da Cruz is chief investigator and surgeon for the bionic eye implantation project in London, which remains the largest recruiting centre in the international trial. Dr da Cruz's interest also includes working with stem cell therapy, translocation surgery for people with age-related macular dystrophy (AMD). He is also currently clinical lead on The London Project for transplanting stem-cell-derived retinal cells for AMD patients.
